Gloucester Community Electricity Aggregation (CEA) gives you stability and security

Launched in December 2018, Gloucester CEA gives electricity customers in Gloucester a city-vetted alternative to National Grid’s Basic Service and to other electricity supply offers in the marketplace, access to cleaner electricity, and long-term, stable pricing.*

Features

- Stable rate till December 2024 - no seasonal rate changes
- Continue to receive a single monthly bill from National Grid
- Same level of service - continue to contact National Grid with service issues
- Compatible with National Grid budget billing and discount utility rate (R2 rate)
- **Most Gloucester residents have already been automatically enrolled in Gloucester CEA’s Local Green product and received an opt-out letter prior to being enrolled – you can check your enrollment status by calling (833) 942-3018**

Automatic Enrollment Option	Gloucester Local Green 11.071 ¢/kWh		Includes 10% more Renewable Energy Certificates (MA Class I RECs) than required by MA
	Gloucester 100% Local Green 14.356 ¢/kWh		Includes Renewable Energy Certificates (MA Class I) to meet 100% of a user's monthly consumption, in addition to meeting all MA renewable energy requirements
	Gloucester Basic 10.706 ¢/kWh		Meets MA renewable energy requirements
